FRONTERA ROAD TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT PROJECT

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The City of El Paso's Capital Improvement Department is starting construction on the Frontera Road Traffic Management project in early June.

This \$340,000 investment aims to safeguard quality of life in El Paso neighborhoods by deterring cut-through traffic and reducing congestion associated with development activity in Sunland Park, New Mexico.

Construction is expected to take approximately four months. The construction schedule may be modified due to weather or other unforeseen events. The public is encouraged to follow posted traffic control signs to safely navigate around the work zone.

The scope of work includes implementing traffic treatment measures along Frontera Road. The improvements include:

- Building a diagonal diverter at Frontera Road and La Adelita Drive, incorporating design elements that include an anchored curb system with delineators, bollards, pedestrian curb ramps, sidewalks, curb, gutter, signage and pavement markings.
- Installing three emergency access swing gates at Gary Lane, Hacienda Roja Drive, and Boy Scout Lane.
